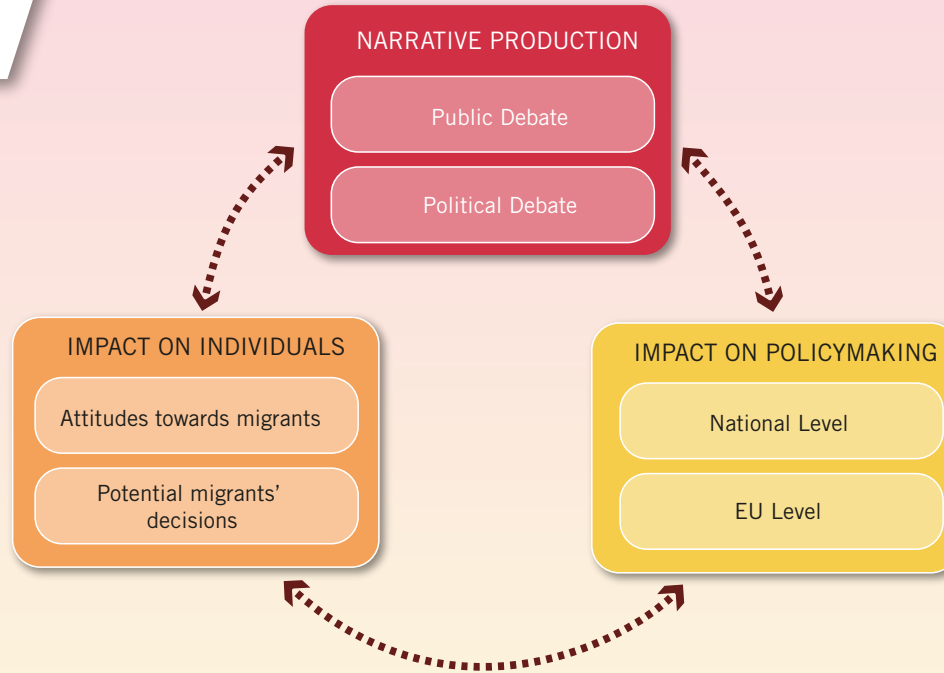

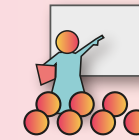

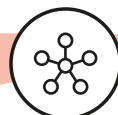
MAIN GOALS
